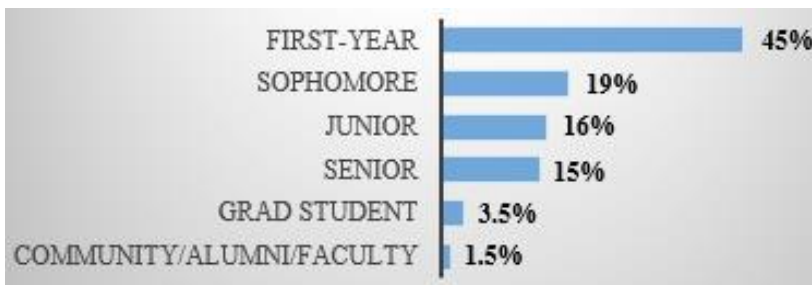
Mission

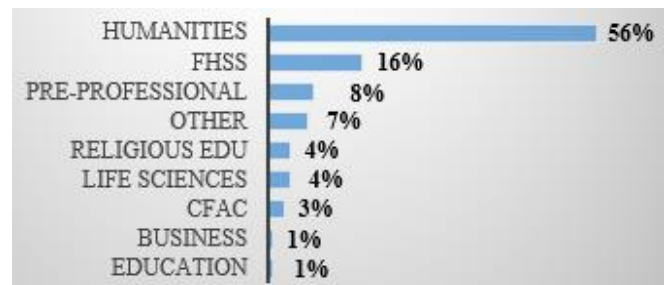
Writing Center Usage and Trends

- **16,832** total consultations: **15,721** writing and **1,111** research (with library staff)
- **48%** increase in total consultations from 2015-2016
- **6,755** unique learners participated in a writing or research consultation
- **769** courses served from over **10** colleges
- **47** certified writing tutors worked, representing **43** areas of study and **8** colleges

Usage by College

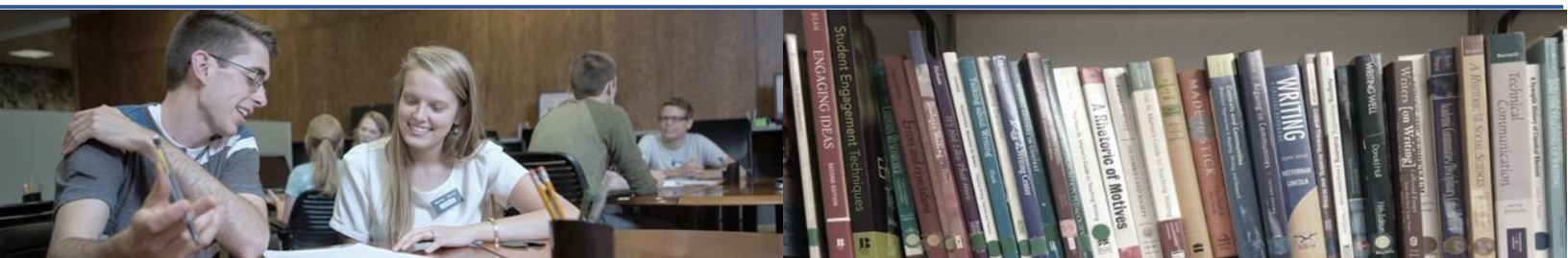


Program Accomplishments and Resource Development
